

# SPONSORSHIP POLICY

The Anointed Works (AW) Sponsorship Policy establishes that this Christian non-profit organization will uphold humane treatment and civil rights towards all people who are known as certified on our website. This policy applies to staff and Certified Creators only. Please do not confuse the Sponsorship Policy with our [Non-Discrimination Policy](#). Although they are similar in wording, both policies differ in terms of delegation and responsibilities of parties.

## Terms & Agreement

Our sponsorship program is free and does not require creators to pay for their sponsorship. Creators do not get paid by AW or anyone associated to AW at any point during their sponsorship and at not point will they be required to pay us for our Services. Our workplace is free of discrimination, harassment and sexual harassment. We affirm that our Christian organization is equal in opportunity and affirm that all creators will be respected and treated equally.

AW forbids discrimination between staff and our clients. AW shall not and creators shall not discriminate against each other because of race, color, nationality, ethnic origin, age, religion/creed, disability, sex, sexual orientation, gender identity and expression, veteran status and any other characteristic protected under applicable federal or state law, herein called “protected categories.” AW expects staff and creators who are represented by AW off the website and those

with accounts to uphold this policy. Should staff or a creator suspect or feel they are being discriminated against, you are *required* to contact the Secretary at once via email or message us on Facebook, Instagram or X in a private DM and tell us what is going on. If you remain silent and do not speak up, the CEO Board cannot help you or fix the situation.

Let it be known we are a true *Christian organization* that follows The Book and are bound by the law of Yahweh-Jehovah. AW will not sponsor people who push for ideologies or political agendas that our faith does not condone or align with morally. Due to the creed, we are bound by, AW *cannot* sponsor people who sincerely want to spread awareness for or advocate for the following themes:

- Abortion
- Rape
- Lying
- Murder
- Theft
- Fornication
- LGBTQ+ Marriage /LGBTQ+ Pride Values
- Polygamy
- Idolatry
- Witchcraft
- Racism/Slavery
- Suicide
- Sexism
- Sex Trafficking
- Pedophilia
- Porn/Sex Addict
- Substance Abuse
- Domestic Violence

- Evolution

So, what does this mean if a person wants to be sponsored for free, but believes in these lifestyles or sees nothing wrong with their beliefs behind these lifestyles? Well, some of the themes listed above are against the law and endanger human life and is not tolerated in the state of Kentucky where we are located. Those kinds of people wanting sponsorship will not only be denied, but reported to the law to prevent a horrible crime from taking place. Depending on what state you live in the themes that are not direct threats or against the law such as LGBTQ+, LGBTQ+ marriage, polygamy, witchcraft, drag queen shows, one's belief that abortion isn't murder, one's belief of evolution, etc. goes directly against our Christian creed of the true Hebrew origin of The Book. Even so, this doesn't give us the right to deny that person sponsorship in general.

The way we are going deal with this is by affirming our sponsorship is strictly bound by taking on people with creativity talents. Creators must understand we will only promote brands for a business, digital creations, crafting, painting, knitting, cleaning, marketing, produce, black smithing, white smithing, woodwork, nature documentaries that record wildlife, pet training, daycare services, etc. Advertising one's sexuality, sexual preferences or one's belief about morals concerning the themes listed above is not allowed. We cannot compromise our creed to suit the wants and desires of other people who do not agree with us, but we can compromise in this way and we believe this is a fair exchange and both sides will be pacified.

If you are thinking about applying for sponsorship with AW, but you do not agree with these Terms then AW is not for you. *Do not send a request for sponsorship.* If you apply for sponsorship with AW, insist to be sponsored and expect us to compromise our creed when you do not agree, we reserve the right the press legal charges if you try to use this disclaimer against us as a means to trap us.

By reading this agreement, creating an account on the website or not creating an account on the website and simply allowing us to sponsor you, you agree to the Terms and Conditions stated in this policy and are legally bound by it until you depart from our Service.

## Guidelines

There are two methods you can select from to be sponsored by AW and claim your creator space. First method requires you to create an account at [www.anointedworks.org](http://www.anointedworks.org). After you do this, you can click the live chat bubble on the lower right corner of the screen and fill out a form. In the body of the form please state the following details:

- State your full name or business name.
- Tell us what your profession is and what you are passionate about.
- Tell us the social media link(s) or your website address, any contact information you want the public to have access to, such as a personal phone number, business number, email address, business email address. All of this information will be listed on your creator space be shared with anyone or sold to third parties. AW has a [Privacy Policy](#) for this sort of thing and we do nothing with user data whatsoever.
- Tell us exactly which social media or website link you want listed in the shoutout that will be posted and shared on our social media platforms every Friday.

The second method doesn't require you to make an account with us, but you'll still be required to send us a message on Facebook, Instagram, X or an email at [anointedworks@outlook.com](mailto:anointedworks@outlook.com) with the details stated above. Between the two, we recommend creating an account simply because you will get a profile section on the website. The profile section is all about creators. It's the perfect place to let followers and supports read more in-depth information about a creators and has more features to offer than the creator space, which lists limited business information. An account that comes with a fully customized profile can be a useful tool for creators if he/she wants to get

personal, post videos, pictures of their work and hyperlink other sources that revolve around their passion.
